
















TRADITIONAL ORDER OF THE PASSOVER SEDER

| KADAYSH קדש |  | Recite the Kiddush. | <i>Initiate special time.</i> |
| URKHATZ ורחץ | Wash the hands. |  | <i>Clear the grime.</i> |
| KARPAS כרפס | Eat a green vegetable. | <i>Open senses to growing green.</i> |  |
| YAKHATZ יחץ | Break the middle Matza and hide half of it for afikomen. | <i>Separate dessert from need.</i> |  |
| MAGID מגיד |  | Recite the Passover story. | <i>Tell a tale from your spiritual past.</i> |
| RAKHTZAH רחצה | Wash the hands before the meal. | <i>Raise up the energy in your hands.</i> |  |
| MOTZI מוציא | Say the ha-Motzi (who brings forth bread...). | <i>Call forth that which nourishes you.</i> |  |
| MATZA מצה | Say the special blessing and eat the matzah. | <i>Increase faith / prepare to heal.</i> |  |
| MAROR מרור | Eat the bitter herb. |  | <i>Allow the bitter to move you</i> |
| KORAYKH כורך | Eat the bitter herb and matza together. | <i>See the sandwich of both sides.</i> |  |
| SHULKHAN ORAYKH שלחן עורר | Serve the festive meal. |  | <i>Enjoy what has been prepared for you.</i> |
| TZAFUN צפון | Eat the Afikomen that was hidden. | <i>Nourish the self with Mystery.</i> |  |
| BARAYKH ברך | Say the grace after meal. | <i>Bless all nourishings in your life.</i> |  |
| HALLEL הלל | Recite the Hallel. |  | <i>Sing the song that is a prayer.</i> |
| NIRTZAH נרצה | Conclude the Seder. | <i>Say, "I am loved here today."</i> |  |
