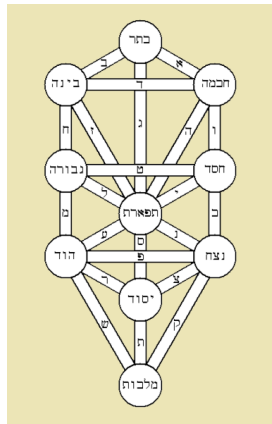


Kabbalistic Arrangement of Symbolic Passover Foods on the Passover Seder Plate

The Pathways of the 10 Sefirot



The three matzot correspond to the three uppermost sefirot.

- ❖ 1st Matzah = **Keter** (or Keter Elyon) = Crown, or The Supreme Crown
- ❖ 2nd Matzah = **Hokhmah** = Wisdom
- ❖ 3rd Matzah = **Binah** = Intelligence, Discernment, or Understanding

- ✚ Below the three matzot, on the right side, the Z'roah (shank bone) corresponds to **Chesed / Gedulah** – Expansive Unconditional Loving-kindness
- ✚ Below the three matzot, on the left side the Beitzah (roasted egg) corresponds to the sefirah or attribute of **Gevurah / Din**: Restraint, Limits, Boundaries, Judgment, Might, or Power.
- ✚ In the center the Maror is placed, which corresponds to **Tiferet**, meaning heart-centered Compassion, Beauty.
- ✚ Below and to the right of Maror, Charoset is placed which corresponds to **Netzach** – Endurance, Victory, and Eternity.
- ✚ Below and to the left of maror, Karpas is placed, which corresponds to **Hod** – Majesty, or Glory.
- ✚ At the bottom of the Pesach seder plate, Chazeret is placed, which corresponds to **Yesod**: Foundation.

The whole meaning the Passover seder plate itself corresponds to **Shekhinah / Malkhut**
