**Selichot: SATURDAY night, September 24, 9 - 11 PM.** This opening service of the HolyDays begins the personal and communal process of *t'shuvah*.  
(For Selichot we meet in our first floor davvenen space)

**Erev Rosh HaShanah: SUNDAY evening, Oct. 2, 6 – 7 PM.** A short, festive gathering for the whole community: singing, *davvenen'*, candle-lighting, and apples & honey.
